Starting 1 July 2004, Mr. Kardel will be the president of the Santa Barbara Association of Health Underwriters.

Mr. Kardel, along with other representatives from the Santa Barbara chapter met with Congresswoman Lois Capps to discuss Health Savings Accounts (HSA's), High Risk Pools (HIPAA and MRMIP), and the uninsured. With approximately 44 million uninsured in the United States, about 15 million are eligible for government sponsored programs but are unaware of them - outreach is a real priority. "Meeting with Congresswoman Capps to discuss California's health insurance issues was an engaging experience - the uninsured is a problem about which we are all concerned. Additionally, developing deep knowledge on products revolutionizing medical insurance like HSA's is crucial in educating the local chapter and providing solid insurance options for our community."
